

FINANCIAL MEMBERSHIP POLICY

PURPOSE

Print Radio Tasmania encourages members of the community and its volunteers to become Financial Members of its organisation. Membership adds to its financial income and provides input from the community on its strategic directions including the financial health and well-being of its operations.

MEMBERS

A person who is nominated and approved for membership may become a member of the organisation on payment of an annual subscription. The current payment is \$20.

Membership should be made in writing and signed by two members of the organisation using the nomination form which should include the consent of the person wishing to nominate. The form should be lodged with the Public Officer.

The Public Officer will advise the committee at its next meeting and seek approval for membership.

Members may resign at any time by advising the Public Officer.

The Public Officer will maintain a register of members which will include date of acceptance as a member; email or postal address; and the date when a person's membership ceased.


HONORARY LIFE MEMBERSHIP

A member may nominate another member for the award of Honorary Life Membership if: the member has been of good standing for not less than five years; and the proposed life member has given outstanding and meritorious service to Print Radio Tasmania.

The committee of management will consider the merit of the nomination and a majority vote will determine whether to confer life membership to the nominee. Honorary Life members are exempt from further payment of the Annual Subscription fee.

EXPULSION OF MEMBERS

The Committee of Management May expel a member from its organisation if, in the opinion of the Committee, the member has been guilty of conduct detrimental to the interest of the Organisation. Rules for the expulsion of members can be found in Article 37 of the Association's Constitution.
